Proiectul EnCaMo - “Enhancement of Căpřiana Monastery for the Promotion of the Unique Ecclesiastic Heritage by Cross-border Cooperation and Digitization”

“Moldova” National Museum Complex of Iași, Romania and Căpřiana Monastery, Republic of Moldova started, on 5 March 2020, the implementation of the project entitled “Enhancement of Căpřiana Monastery for the Promotion of the Unique Ecclesiastic Heritage by Cross-border Cooperation and Digitization”, 2SOFT/2.1.76 (EnCaMo). The project, financed under the Joint Operational Programme Romania-Republic of Moldova 2014-2020, Thematic Objective 3, Priority 2.1, through the European Neighbourhood Instrument (ENI), has an 18 month- duration, and has as objectives the conservation, valorisation and touristic promotion of the unique ecclesiastic patrimony, with historical value, a common trans-national heritage, by establishing, at Căpřiana Monastery, the first religious museum of the Republic of Moldova based on an ecclesiastic heritage discovered during the archaeological researches conducted at Căpřiana Monastery, and through the organization of a permanent digital exhibition at “Moldova” National Museum Complex of Iași, Romania, with the purpose of increasing the number of tourists.

The press conference dedicated to the launching of the EnCaMo project will take place Tuesday, 28 July 2020, at 11 o'clock, in the inner courtyard 2 of the Palace of Culture, complying with the social distancing and prevention measures due to Covid-19 pandemics. The team of the Moldovan partner will be present online, with the help of information technology tools.
