In the framework of the international project Refresh+: "Young artists refreshing heritage sites and legends", we are looking for *4 artists from Romania*, *18-30 years old* to become part of an international multidisciplinary team and participate in co-creation processes.

This call is for you if you are:

- 18-30 years old
- student, recent graduate or in the early stage of your career;
- active in the field of visual arts, including new media, film and video, performing arts, including music, dance, theatre and circus
- interested in tangible and intangible cultural heritage
- open minded and curious
- willing to engage in co-creation processes, work interdisciplinary and in collaboration with others
- have a good knowledge of English

Selected artists will:

- Be part of the Refresh+ team throughout the project, working on innovative approaches to interpretation of heritage and legends
- Participate, together with 13 other artists from Romania, Slovenia, Finland and Spain in the 5-day Bootcamp organized in Split (Croatia) in April 2021 (travel and accommodation costs covered)
- Participate in the production week in Slovenia (October 2021) or Romania (February 2022) (travel, accommodation and production costs covered)
- Be provided with coaching and mentorship during the whole process including the marketing training in Spain (June 2022)
- Learn and develop co-creation strategies
- Have their work presented and promoted internationally
- Be part of the international network
